

SUPPLIER COMPLIANCE STATEMENT - SUBSTANCES IN PACKAGING (ARTICLE 5)

Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste

BFC continually monitors the regulatory, health, safety and environmental requirements relevant to the packaging products supplied to its customers.

In accordance with Article 16 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR) and based on the information and supporting documentation available from our packaging supply chain, BFC provides the following information to support customers in demonstrating compliance with the applicable requirements of Article 5: Requirements for Substances in Packaging.

Article 5(1) - Substances of Concern

Based on the information available from our packaging supply chain, including declarations and supporting documentation maintained as part of our compliance records, BFC is not aware of the presence of substances of concern in quantities that would prevent compliance with the applicable requirements of Article 5.

Article 5(4) - Heavy Metals

Based on available supplier information and supporting evidence, the sum of the concentrations of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium does not exceed 100 mg/kg of the packaging or packaging components supplied.

Supporting Documentation

Relevant material specifications, supplier declarations, test reports and other supporting technical information are maintained as part of BFC compliance records and can be provided where necessary to support customer PPWR conformity assessments.

Where documentation is requested by a competent national authority in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2025/40, Tibbetts will cooperate in supporting the provision of relevant documentation within the applicable regulatory timeframe.
